

128 Technology Configuration and Administration Basics

COURSE OVERVIEW

128T Configuration and Administration Basics Training will teach students how to configure and use a 128T router and conductor. It starts with an introduction to 128 Technology and then moves to an introduction to the PCLI and GUI. After that, the students use the GUI to deploy and configure their 128Ts. They will learn how to configure and build their network from the ground up starting with servers that just have the CentOS operating system installed and ending with a fully deployed network which will contain multiple paths, three 128T routers, and one 128T conductor.

This course is designed for anyone using 128Ts.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the students should be able to:

- Install a 128T Router and Conductor
- Access 128Ts with both the PCLI and the GUI
- Route traffic to a datacenter using 128Ts
- Configure a 128T using Zero-Touch Provisioning
- Troubleshoot 128Ts
- Know where to go for further resources
